

Course Description

This conference will provide an update on workup and management of patients with cardiovascular and peripheral vascular disease.

The topics will include evaluation and workup of the most prevalent presentations of patients with diseases in the cardiac as well as the peripheral vascular system. This conference also includes a breakout session to update new medications for cardiovascular disease as well as pre- and post-op treatment of cardiovascular disease states.

Target Audience

This conference is designed for primary care physicians, including medical and surgical specialists, WVU, UHC and Charleston residents, CathLab and Vascular Lab technologists, cardiology fellows, nurses, medical students, and nursing students.

- Better understand how to read EKG's
- Describe post-CABG and post carotid treatment care
- Recognize which vascular tests to order
- Better understand atrial fibrillation and anticoagulation

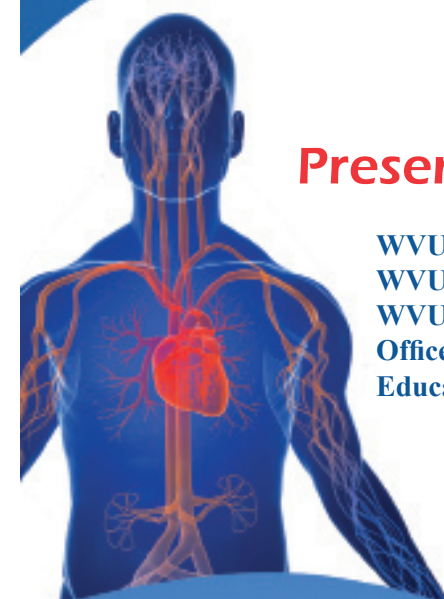
